We are excited that you are interested in coming back to work or volunteer at Birch Bay Ranch! Just a reminder, we are a Christian camp geared at telling campers between the ages of 8-16 about the love of Jesus Christ. We believe that the Bible is the TRUTH - that every word of it was inspired by God and is valid today as a tool to live by (II Timothy 3:16).

We hire 12-14 people to work for May, June, July and August, and 20-25 more to volunteer for July and August. Staff can agree to work the entire two months of July and August, or, if they are only available on a weekly basis they can indicate which weeks they are able to work. Staff will be notified in April if they have been hired for May-August, and in June if they have been hired for the summer months. Very few of the staff are hired to a specific position.
