2018 Dear Returning Staff Member:

We are excited that you are interested in coming back to work or volunteer at Birch Bay Ranch! Just a reminder, we are a Christian camp geared at telling campers between the ages of 8-16 about the love of Jesus Christ. We believe that the Bible is the TRUTH - that every word of it was inspired by God and is valid today as a tool to live by (II Timothy 3:16).

We hire 12-14 people to work for May, June, July and August, and 20-25 more to volunteer for July and August. Staff can agree to work the entire two months of July and August, or, if they are only available on a weekly basis they can indicate which weeks they are able to work. Staff will be notified in April if they have been hired for May-August, and in June if they have been hired for the summer months. Very few of the staff are hired to a specific position. Most of the staff will be asked to serve in any area in the ministry of the Ranch. This may change on a weekly basis.

Please be sure that you are prepared in your heart to treat the Ranch as a mission field and that your commitment to the campers, leadership and the other staff is a commitment of love and effort.

The following dates are important for you to remember:

STAFF ORIENTATION WEEKEND:

Friday, June 1 beginning at 7:30pm until Sunday, June 3 at 2:00pm.

This is a mandatory weekend for all staff applying for the summer. This will be a time for us to get to know you and for you to find out more about the Ranch. If you have circumstances that do not allow you to attend, please contact the Ranch (780-922-2883). The cost for the weekend is FREE!

STAFF TRAINING: **These dates are mandatory** for all staff who have been hired to work or volunteer for the summer. It will begin on Thursday, June 28 at 5:00 pm and will finish Saturday, June 30 at 7:00 pm. Summer camp starts Sunday, July 1 with a staff meeting beginning at 2:00pm.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

"We believe in the divine inspiration, truthfulness, and authority of both the Old and New Testaments, in their entirety; that the Bible is the written word of God without error."
