#### 2019 Dear Interested Staff Member:

Thank you for inquiring about employment and/or volunteering at Birch Bay Ranch. We are a Christian camp geared at telling campers between the ages of 8-16 about the love of Jesus Christ. We believe that the Bible is the TRUTH - that every word of it was inspired by God and is valid today as a tool to live by (II Timothy 3:16).

Birch Bay Ranch is located on Cooking Lake, near Edmonton, Alberta and covers 104 acres of beautifully treed land. From September to June the Ranch operates as a retreat centre for groups wanting to stay overnight and/or use the various activities of the Ranch. In July and August the Ranch is a summer camp for youths between the ages of 8 -16. Ranch activities include horseback riding, an extensive ropes course, archery, small outdoor pool, gym and field sports. In the summer we also have devotional times, and campfires. Staff can expect to work in any of the above areas, as well as cabin leaders, in the kitchen, lodge maintenance (cleaning), outdoor maintenance or anywhere else that help is required.

We hire 12-14 people to work/volunteer for May, June, July and August, and 20-25 more to volunteer for July and August. Staff can agree to work the entire two months of July and August, or, if they are only available on a weekly basis, they can indicate which weeks they are able to work. Staff will be notified in April if they have been hired for May-August and in June if they have been hired for the summer months. Very few staff are hired to a specific position. Most staff will be asked to serve in any area in the ministry of the Ranch. This may change on a weekly basis.

Birch Bay Ranch is a mission field in the same sense as Africa or China is considered missions. Staff who apply to work at the Ranch need to be prepared to commit their summer (or the amount of time they apply for) to the Lord, knowing that our purpose is to lead campers to Christ. This commitment is a 24-hour a day, 6 days per week commitment. It requires a sacrifice of time and abilities. When you apply to work at the Ranch you need to be aware that you are laying aside all other plans to concentrate your effort on the campers who attend summer camp.

A typical week for summer staff members will begin at 2:00pm on Sunday with a devotional time and staff meeting in our Main Lodge. All staff are required to be in attendance. Campers arrive at 4:30pm. All week the campers participate in various activities and are instructed, counseled and served by the staff. On Friday evening campers are involved in a Ranch Finale (run by staff) for their parents beginning at 7:00pm. The Finale ends at about 8:30pm at which time all staff are required to complete their cleanup duties before they are free to leave the Ranch (usually ready to leave the Ranch by 10:00pm on Friday evening). All staff will have Saturdays off.

We are thankful that you are interested in applying for work at Birch Bay Ranch and we would ask that you will prayerfully consider whether this is where God wants you. Once again, please be sure that you are prepared in your heart to treat the Ranch as a mission field and that your commitment to the campers, leadership and the other staff is a commitment of love and effort.
